Inhalte	In this module the understanding of partner work within the contemporary dance frame-work will be developed. Established partnering techniques, plus complex lifts and elements of contact improvisation, are utilized in this module. This module consists of a newly created works by well know and emerging choreographers from the Swiss and international dance world. The choreographies will be varied and challenging preparing the student. The student will deepen his technical ability, presentation and interpretation. Where possible the student will perform in presentations and public performances
