Inhalte	Mixed teams from the different schools choose one or more of the above mentioned topics - society, culture, economy, education, gender or environment -, analyze and reflect on the subject, presenting their theses at the end. The form of the results is defined by the individual teams: it can be a book, a magazine, a film, a posterseries, a comic, a podcast etc. In the final presentation, the individual teams introduce their thoughts, their proposal and a documentation of the work process.
