In his photography, installations and film sequences, Ueberschär develops spatial scenarios at the interface between reality and fiction. He has had numerous solo and group exhibitions in Germany, Holland, Spain, Korea, Italy, France and China. Workshops and lectures, among others at the Academy of Art Nuremberg and the Musée de l'Elysée Lausanne.</p> <p>Martin Jaeggi (*1968) is an author, editor, curator, and lecturer. He studied film and video at the School of Visual Arts, New York, and the San Francisco Art Institute. Numerous publications on contemporary art and photography in newspapers, magazines and books.</p>
